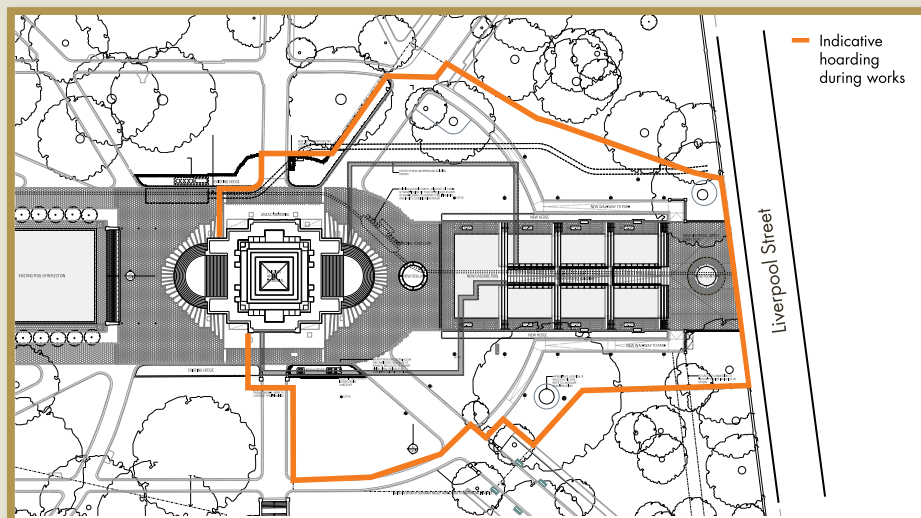
About the Project

As Australia marks the 100th anniversary of the First World War the NSW Government, together with the Trustees, is enhancing the Anzac Memorial. The project will realise the vision of the original architect, Bruce Dellit, and introduce new spaces for the community, allowing the Memorial to tell the stories of NSW's involvement in all military and peace-keeping missions and honour those who have served. Construction Information

What to expect during construction:

- Hoardings enclosing the Anzac Memorial Centenary Project construction area will be installed during the next couple of weeks.
- All efforts will be made to minimise disruption. Daily commemorative services will continue.

Construction Program

Works will commence in early September with works due to be completed as the centenary commemorations draw to a close in 2018.

Access

The public will be able to access parts of the Memorial throughout all the phases of construction. Entry points may change but will always be clearly sign-posted. Pedestrian paths will be modified within the Memorial's precinct in Hyde Park South in collaboration with the City of Sydney to avoid construction zones while ensuring the public's access and enjoyment of Hyde Park is maintained.

Construction equipment and materials will be delivered onto the site via Liverpool Street, with all efforts made to minimise impact to pedestrians and local traffic.
