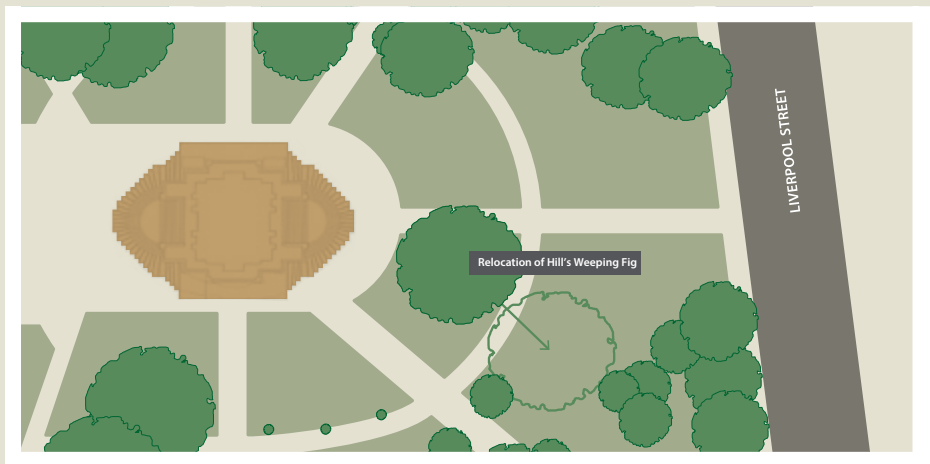
### Construction Update

New hoarding and access points have been completed on Liverpool Street to allow for the entry and exit of equipment and materials for the project. Large information boards have recently been installed along the hoarding to provide the community with more information about the project and Bruce Dellit's original vision for the Memorial.

Piling and excavation works are underway for the construction of the new water cascade and underground Hall of Service, interpretation and education facilities. These works will continue over the coming months before the new foundations are laid.

## Upcoming works

The large Hill's Weeping Fig currently located to the south west of the Memorial will be relocated early next month to remove the risk of damage to the tree during construction and to maintain the integrity of the original 1930s design of the Memorial.

Work to prepare the tree's root plate for relocation was completed in October last year and the tree has been monitored on a regular basis by an appointed arborist and is in good health.

The tree will be relocated approximately 15 metres after three days of set up work including installing steel beams and hydraulic bladders under the root ball of the tree. The relocation will be managed and overseen by experienced arborists.

Following the relocation, it is expected the tree will lose its foliage as it acclimatises to its new location. This is normal and not an indication of the tree's health. It is expected the tree will recover within 6 to 12 months.
